Karlheinz Weinberger, employed all his life as a warehouse keeper in the factory of Siemens, will devote his free time to photograph, from the years 1950, the rebellious youth, the Halbstarke, the marginal young people in Switzerland. It is with great tenderness and a touch of irony that he portrays this post-war generation in search of identity. With an always erotic look, he makes young rebels, and later bikers and rockers, pose in his apartment or during their escapades in the countryside. Karlheinz Weinberger's images paint an explosive portrait of a non-conformist Switzerland.
